## **INTRODUCTION OF THE ORGANIZATION**

## **INITIATIVES TAKEN FOR PROMOTION OF SPORTS**


Sports has been defined generally as an activity involving physical exertion and skill in which an individual or team competes against another or others for entertainment. Team sports such as football is most appreciated and enjoyed by the whole world. The attachment of tribal people of Assam especially in the field of football is seamlessly thriving. Where ever we go in the Tribal Areas it is clearly visible the enthusiasm of young boys to run behind the foot ball. Whichever empty rice field after cultivation is made to

football grounds and local level tournaments are organized by local clubs and association to promote the football skills. ISDI being the responsible firm has been took part in conducting and promoting Football in the area Mirza (Kamrup District Guwahati).

Football as game of sport , has both its own economic and political consequences in the life of any state. Without sports a nation is as good as extinct, erased from the surface of the earth, blotted out and, an existence without dignity or recognition. The only way to wipe out a people from the face of the earth is to take away their sporting ability. We must make an effort to promote the sporting skills of our people. Some of the activities performed by the organization to preserve and promote the sports are:-

1. Football Coaching camp were conducted in the month of April for 30days from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> April. Total 30 participants took part in the camp. Necessary kitting and Football were given to the participants in addition to the daily coaching fee. Adequate refreshment and necessary arrangements were made to the participants for the smooth conducting of the event.

2. Basic Football skills including receiving the ball, tackling, interception, short passes layered defending as well as attacking tactics were imparted to the participants during the course of the coaching camp. Techniques to carryout penalty kick, corner kick, free kick in best possible manner were taught to the participants. Goalkeeping techniques were taught to four of the participants who have potential goal keeping ability.

## **AREA OF INTERVENTION PROPOSED**

ISDI has been working to revive and preserve the traditions and ethos of many communities living in the region of North East. The society's efforts take in the conservation of tribal cultural and sporting traditions in the field handicrafts including their cultural bio-diversity and improve artisan's participation through income generation. In conservation of sports ISDI has been providing support to promote Football by conducting coaching camps during the school vacation, organizing local level tournaments, creating awareness seminar and workshops to attract kids as well as parents in the field of sports. It was visible after the victory of many of our sports personalities from Assam, sports will be now considered as serious business unlike just physical fitness maintaining activity.

ISDI has earmarked a football field in Laharpara village in Chandrapur, Kamrup district. Water logging in the monsoon and uneven plane in some part of the field due various activities of farmers made it bit difficult this ground to be fit for smooth conducting of football. Efforts are to be made to bring back the field leveled and pathways are to be constructed digging along with boundaries to drain out rain water to avoid water logging in the ground. Standard size goal post needs to be positioned along with nets in addition to make the ground available for playing.

ISDI identified **30 Bodo** boys 12-21 years of age from **Laharpara village, Chandrapur, in Kamrup district** who are potential football players, and capable to take the game of football in to higher standards.

## **INITIATIVES TO BE TAKEN:**

To organize a Football coaching for 30 ST boys at Lahapara village, Chandarpur, District-kamrup(R), Assam with an objective to –

- Improve their orientation towards the game,
- Provide necessary football kit for each participate
- Encouraging future generations to take part in sporting events.
